Directions to Museum

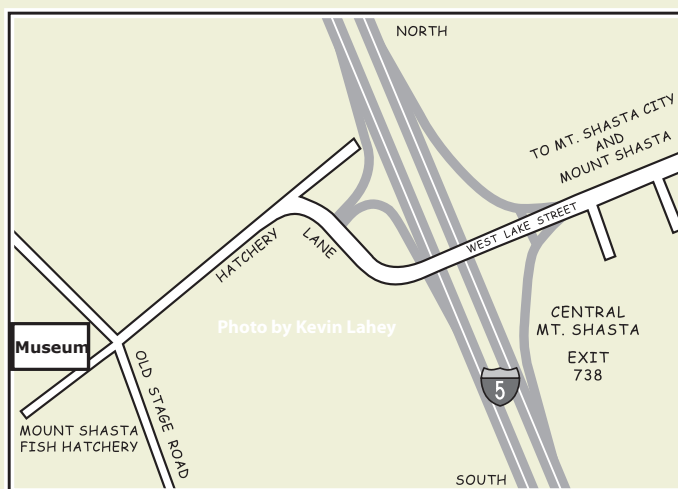
Just 1/2 mile off I-5

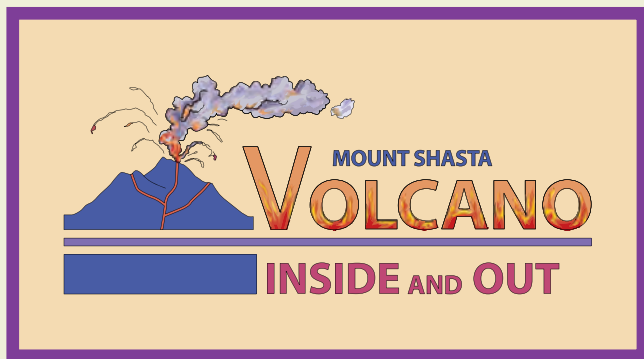

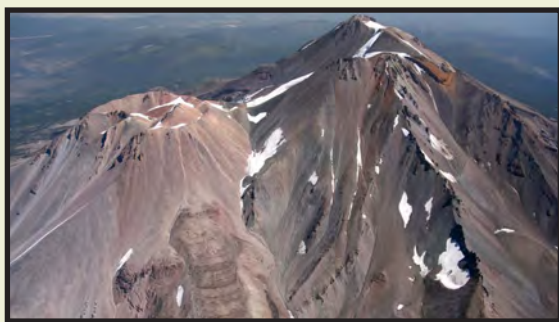
